

## Topical CBD gel for the treatment of symptoms related to 22q.11.2 Deletion Syndrome

### **Clinical Trial Sites now open in Brisbane and Melbourne**

#### **ZYN2-CL-031: An Open-Label, Tolerability and Efficacy Study of ZYN002 Administered as a Transdermal Gel to Children and Adolescents with 22q11.2 Deletion Syndrome (INSPIRE)**

Children's Health Queensland and Genetic Clinics Australia are currently conducting a clinical trial investigating the safety and efficacy of ZYN002 (a cannabidiol topical gel) for the treatment of symptoms related to 22q.11.2 (22qDS) Deletion Syndrome including anxiety and irritability.

We are seeking male and female participants aged 4-17 years with a confirmed diagnosis of 22qDS (molecular confirmation) to undertake 14 weeks of open label treatment (every participant will receive the study drug). Treatment involves applying the study drug as a topical gel on the skin twice a day for the duration of the 14-week treatment period (3 study visits). At the end of the treatment period, participants who are eligible will be able to enrol in a 6-month extension study to continue receiving the study drug (3 additional study visits).

As this is a safety and efficacy study, participants will be required to have blood tests, ECGs and vital signs taken throughout the study, so that the study team may effectively monitor their safety whilst taking the study drug.

Study visits will take place at one of the following locations:

- The Centre for Children's Health Research Clinical Research Facility, located behind the Queensland Children's Hospital at South Brisbane.
- Genetic Clinics Australia at North Caulfield in Melbourne
